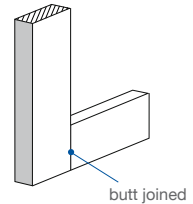

Two identical Frames sandwich the Core layer in a patented process that fuses the three layers together, essentially turning the Core into a structural element. The result of this method of construction is a strong, lightweight, durable panel that is safer than glass with virtually the same sound insulation. We offer both standard and custom options, allowing you to create the right look for your space.

FRAMES

Frames come in Real Wood Veneer and High-Quality Laminate. The standard width of the rails and stiles is 3 inches.

REAL WOOD VENEERS

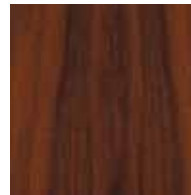

CORES

Core layers are 1/4" thick and can be transparent, frosted, opaque or patterned. Light filters throughout the panel, producing our signature RAY EDGE if you look at the door from the side. RAYDOOR works with third party acrylic, resin and digital sources should you have a specific color or style in mind.
